Galerie Ashiya Schule is pleased to present Makoto Kumagai, Jun Koshino and Akiko Horio's group show titled 'beyond time' from January 15th to February 5th.

Makoto Kumagai has created his works by making prints, oil paintings, and sculptures. In late years, he chose shed, clothes, diary as subjects which his late father left. He produces his works by carefully tracing memory of his father and it is the act of the contemplation to spin past and present.

Jun Koshino has looked for his own way in the theme of the picture of a simple color. He makes the works which trimmed concrete form until which we just mistake for in the lump of the color.

Akiko Horio creating works for a long time from the 1960s produces a plane and a solid piece of art consisting of the element which is a minimum. All work titles "are untitled works" and the thought that transcends the times is embodied in her works.

The works of 3 artists have a static world that deviated from everyday life.
