Galerie Ashiya Schule is pleased to present *Step*, an exhibition of new works by Hiroshi Mizuta, on view from March 1 through 16, 2014. Hiroshi Mizuta has been represented by galleries in Japan since 2005. After his successful first solo exhibition at Artcourt Gallery, Osaka in 2008, he participated in several exhibitions in Japan: Keifu Gallery, Kyoto City University of Arts Art Gallery@KCUA 2013. His works are in the collection of the Museum of Modern Art Wakayama, Daiwa Radiator Group in Shimane, Hitotsubashi University in Tokyo. This is the first solo exhibition of the artist in Hyogo, presenting mainly new ones from the series of *Step*. Hiroshi Mizuta evokes a notion to release his perception and recognize something from different viewpoints which relate to time, space and body.

In the works by Hiroshi Mizuta, we find concrete motifs as cars, highway, and walking men. When one escapes congestion and walks a byway, he or she encounters a scene in which every sense is organically combined—warmth and coldness, loud sound and small sound. The expanse of colors and detail of continuous patterns seem to be various values like gradation.
