Galerie Ashiya Schule is proud to present "Objectively", a solo exhibition of works by Hiroko Nakakita opening on February 23, 2019.

Hiroko Nakakita has described incompatible concepts of artificial forms created by humans as well as forms created by nature. Human feelings are expressed by motifs like flowers and chandeliers.

A brilliant chandelier is accompanied with dressed up people and jewelries at a party. A chandelier which overlooks the party hall is the important motif in her works on the theme of "Objectively". Also colorful flowers in nature are used to express human feelings. Nakakita uses original medium composed of sand and diorama with oil. Jewelries serve to construct 3-dimentional space in her works. Excessive colors and chaotic ingredients create an "objective" view beyond superficial image as a whole. This exhibition includes oil paintings and a work with 3-dimentional installations.

We will introduce the works of "Objectively" and create a platform where figures from all ages can converse with Nakakita's artistic realm. We are looking forward to your visit.

The world is made up of artificial forms created by humans as well as forms created by nature. Humans are instinctively drawn toward living a natural life.

However, life compels humans to live with intent and logic in order to navigate the world.

I use flower and chandelier motifs to convey the fragility, ruthlessness, and strength of the human heart, balancing both the natural and artificial.

When this balance of the natural and artificial can be struck in the heart and captured on canvas, I believe beauty comes to life.
