Galerie Ashiya Schule is pleased to present *Snow Blossoms*, an exhibition of new works by Seiko Wakasugi, on view from March 19 through April 6, 2014. She has created works in the atelier used by the late Takako Araki, who was well-known for ceramic objects, in Sanda, Hyogo, in the bosom of nature.

Seiko Wakasugi has been represented by galleries in Japan since 2004. This is the second solo exhibition of the artist in Galerie Ashiya Schule, presenting mainly new ones from the series of *Snow Blossoms*.

Her works include white porcelain containers in a mold and plates made on a potter's wheel.

With the feel of Japanese paper made from mulberry, her works are constructed with fine details and elaborate design.

Last autumn she sent her works to the modern ceramic arts salon at Ceramique 14, Paris, and to the exhibition at Mercier & Associates Gallery. In the exhibition at Galerie Ashiya Schule, you will find her vases and objects favorably received in Paris.
